The Hunter Presbytery Prayer Diary



This diary provides an opportunity to pray each week for congregations in the Presbytery. By praying together, we can encourage one another in mission, as we grow in faith and unity and develop understanding and relationships across the region. Each week there will be information and a prayer for each of the congregations in the Hunter Presbytery. This week we pray for:

27th October 2024 — Grahamstown-Tilligerry & Medowie Uniting Churches Tilligerry Uniting Church at Tanilba Bay is located on the shores of Port Stephens. Medowie Uniting Church is 20 kms away, also in Port Stephens LGA, on the edge of Grahamstown Dam (on the lands of the Worimi people). These centres are two of five worship centres making up Grahamstown Multi-Centre Congregation. The two centres alternate worship, each hosting in turn. Each is a welcoming place in the community. Together, our folk are a living example of God's love in the community. They remain active and innovative.

Prayer: We pray for our Uniting Church family at Tilligerry and Medowie. Gracious God be with them, encouraging and connecting these communities of faith as they look to the future. Please bless them; guide, equip and enrich them, as they consider initiatives and projects, ensuring their worship centres are a vibrant and welcoming place in their communities. We thank you for the spiritual oversight and guidance through your servant in ministry, Waisea (pron: why-say-ah) and the lay preachers who minister to your people in all centres in Grahamstown. Amen.

Spiritual Practice of the Week

Pilgrimage: Pilgrimage is a practice of walking to or visiting a holy site with prayerful intention to be more than a tourist, as well as prayerful attention to the Holy Spirit's movements within.

Practice: Intentionally take a pilgrimage with others – you can go somewhere near. For example, visit a beautiful church in your area, or a part of creation that leads you to worship God. Intentionally leave something behind. Ask God to speak to you through your journey. Talk with your friends about what comes up for you.


